Think critically about the social implications of the technology I build and interact with daily!

I will apply the 7 principles!

I'm hoping to teach data feminism to my minoritised communities I have access to to grow data feminists.

Look at what projects I'm working on that I can apply a data feminist lens.

Getting comfortable/educated on how to talk about these topics and practice how to communicate the importance

I will be sharing what I've read and the thoughts shared in group discussions with my colleagues.

These concepts are critical for my consulting work. I'm currently in the process of refining how I articulate my approach and plan to cite many of the concepts and ideas discussed in the book when doing so.

I'm working on several DE&I initiatives right now, so this content is PERFECT for helping me frame ideas to people who are new them (and obsessed with "flat" data).

Basically just slow down and ask the questions that the book presented for me: by whom, for whom and furthering whose goals?

Have a focus on intersectionality as well as using the four domains of matrix domination.

I plan to incorporate what I've learned so far in my daily life by recommending this book to other kids my age and by continuing to inform the youth throughout my community about the various opportunities offered in data science.
